



PHOTO LICENSE REQUESTS

Photography licenses will only be issued to those persons who stand to/plan to profit from sales of their photos

Langley Speedway reserves the right to approve or deny license requests, as well as number of granted credentials

There are only six (6) licenses available for any given event excluding special events where more may be available

Applying for a license does not mean that a license will be issued

At the Promoter's discretion, a maximum of two (2) licenses may be issued to a single photography organization. Only one (1) person per organization will have Victory Lane access.

All photography license applications must be submitted to Langley Speedway no later than seven (7) days prior to the event. Photographers may apply for select dates or all dates.

Photographers gaining a license must wear the provided photography vests assigned to them and return them before they leave the premises.

Photographers gaining a license must provide all photographs taken at an event to Langley Speedway within three (3) working days or they must grant access to download photos from their photography website.

Photographers gaining a license will be able to sell any products on the grounds

Photographers gaining a license will have access to the infield with the exception of the Tech Shed.

Photographers gaining a license will be able to access the race track for shots during the pre-race show, before certain races, and during intermission, but they are not to impede the progress of the race show.

Those gaining a photography license must adhere to the rules and regulations set forth by Langley Speedway. Failure to comply with the direction of track officials will result in revocation of photography license for the remainder of the event and possibly future events.
